Sustainability: how will we achieve it?



Educate our stakeholders on the 'Sustainability' advice from World Rugby and apply where possible to a Philippine Rugby landscape and environment

On a Social context:

- 1. Continue to use Rugby programs to engage communities during and post major events where possible
- 2. Whilst hosting and sanctioning domestic competitions, promote sustainability actions. Lead by example.
- 3. Source and use suppliers that use ethical and sustainable products when purchasing for the Union
- 4. Continue to source volunteers locally and globally
- 5. Encourage community volunteer programs and fundraising initiatives

On a Economic context:

- 1. Continue to reinvest into the game
- 2. Continue to identify and partner with government funding initiatives via Olympic Solidarity Funding, Australia and NZ Aid projects).
- 3. Improve efficiencies in systems and processes to better manage resources via PRFU newly implemented policies



On a Environmental context:

- 1. Video conferencing calls to important stakeholders to reduce travel
- 2. Ensure and encourage grouped meetings to maximise events
- 3. Reduce/Reuse/Recycle where possible, most evidently sponsors signage, staff clothing and equipment
- 4. Encourage the PRFU headquarters to be an energy-efficient workplace, with smart lighting, water, printing and recycling stations
- 5. Support for used PRFU kit and equipment



How do we implement it? Philippine Rugby to support sustainable initiatives provided by World Rugby



Foods and drinks at Domestic Competitions:

- Avoid single-use products
- Players and teams to use water bottles
- Request for seasonal food to be sold at venues
- Reduce food waste
- Re-use bags when packing
- Purchase products that are certified/labelled environmentally friendly for the competition

Travelling to and from Rugby, and in general:

- Travel light more weight increases fuel consumption
- Walk or cycle to training or the game
- Car pool or use public transport where possible
- Take the stairs instead of the lift or escalator if possible

Waste disposal at Domestic Competitions

- Limit use of packaging
- Sort all garbage into recyclables, compost or waste
- No littering and clean entire venues after use





Accommodation when traveling for Rugby:

- Re-use towels in the hotel to save water
- Turn off all electricity when not in the hotel room
- Always bring your own bathroom supplies
- Choose accommodation close to venues so you can walk
- Accommodate more people in one room

Rugby & Sports equipment:

- Ask players and coaches to donate old Rugby and sports equipment to those who need it
- Look to purchase sustainable and ethically produced clothing and equipment for Rugby

Clubs and Venues:

- Support local community initiatives, schools outreach programs
- Look at venue share/multi-user opportunities to increase efficiencies and reduce costs
- Consider investing in updated facilities including smart lighting, rain water recycling for pitch watering/toilets
- Install recycling facilities
- Encourage local flora and fauna and avoid construction/ activities on or near sensitive habitats/ecosystems;
- Source local suppliers
- Consider proximity to public transport links
- Encourage healthy lifestyle through no-smoking venues, healthy food options, family zones etc.
- Promote our sustainability objectives, activities and results
